Serving the extended Catholic family of Schenectady and the greater Schenectady community for the past 10 years, we have lived our faith by living the works of mercy. Together, we have:

- Clothed almost 3,000 children in our community through our Good Neighbor Program
- Come together annually on *Called to Serve Family Sunday* to learn about and support * programs in our community who serve our neighbors in their times of need
- Trained and supported visitation ministers who serve the homebound and those in nursing * homes and senior residences
- Been a resource to those who need a helping hand, a listening ear, and a caring heart *
- And much more!

Together, we have served with love and compassion. We have lived our faith through our works. Enduring through the challenges brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic, we were able to continue to serve. Our Good Neighbor Program volunteers quickly and seamlessly adjusted to new protocols so we could continue to provide for the children who needed us.
